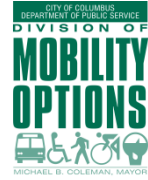




Please Come See Proposed Changes to the Hilltop Transportation System

The City of Columbus' goal is to create livable communities that are safe and enjoyable for all citizens, whether you walk, ride a bicycle or drive. Community mobility planning is a comprehensive approach that looks at all modes of transportation. Its success depends upon input from the community.

What will happen at these open houses?

The study team will be available to discuss proposed recommendations to achieve more balanced transportation infrastructure in the Hilltop community. Maps and other material will be on display for viewing by the public. The recommendations include:

- Proposed changes to W. Broad Street
- Proposed changes to W. Mound Street
- Proposed changes to neighborhood streets
- Bikeway facilities
- Pedestrian connectivity

Why should I attend this meeting?

- The study team would like to hear your comments so it can make any changes before recommendations are incorporated into the final plan.
- This plan will serve as input into the city's annual capital budgeting and prioritization process. The recommended improvements in the plan will be programmed for design and construction *as funds become available*.
