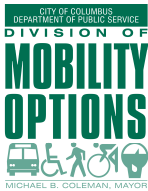


Walk with City mobility engineers and help identify transportation problems on "Walk Audits" in the Hilltop!

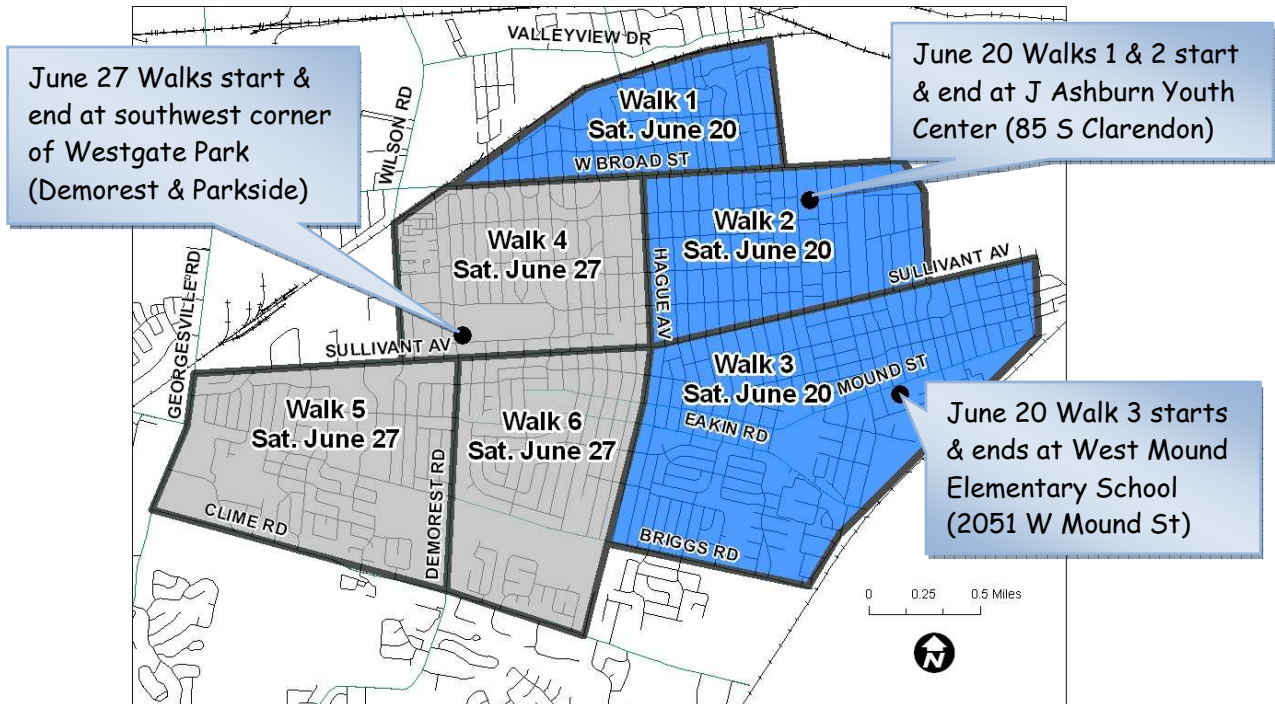
